KINETIKA IS PROUD TO PRESENT AN EXHIBITION THAT CELEBRATES 5 YEARS OF T100. IT IS AVAILABLE TO TOUR TO VENUES OR EVENTS, FROM AUGUST 2020.

T100 is an annual walking, talking and making festival.

What began as a 100-mile marathon across the borough, has developed into a festival that starts and ends in Thurrock and stretches along and across the estuary, into Southend and over to Kent. Leading up to the festival, activities are undertaken in libraries, schools and community spaces. They have included writing, drawing, cooking, painting, researching, dancing and acting. The results add colour to the walks which have incorporated heritage talks, shared community meals, outdoor theatre, silk flags reflecting local stories, singing and even the making and performing of an animated 12-foot-tall Tilbury Docker puppet designed by local high school students. The magic of T100 is its simplicity as a framework. Responding to an annual theme, it enables groups to come up with their own ideas, develop them as separate projects then showcase and share them to the wider community as part of the ten-day festival.

T100 has surpassed project ambitions in so many ways. It is an interwoven web of community relationships, informing and supporting the artistic response instigated and guided by Kinetika and local community leaders.

The depth of the T100 festivals proves how embedded and established it is within the local landscape and how listening is pivotal to artistic integrity and co-creation. The future is bound to be colourful, richly layered in exciting content. Thank you for shining a light on Thurrock in ways beyond words.


Through informative and colourful storyboards, the T100 exhibition captures the spirit of the festival and the people and places who have taken part along the routes over the last five years.

The exhibition can be configured in various ways. It is designed to be very flexible and can be tailored to suit the space available:

- **At its most simple for the smallest space, one double sided display board summarises the story and includes the route map**
- **For a moderate space, two double-sided boards add more detail plus information on the 2020 festival**
- **For large spaces, four double-sided boards tell the whole story - giving full details of each individual year**


The storyboards can be accompanied by any combination of the following:

- **An iPad on a floor-standing podium, displaying a rolling slideshow and videos for more in-depth coverage of the festival**
- **Physical examples of any number of artefacts from the festival. For example handmade journals, silk flags (both large or small), printed tablecloths, maps and recipes are all available**
- **Kinetika staff and volunteers will deliver, assemble and if appropriate can staff the exhibition**
- **The exhibition is free to hire**
- **It can be installed for a few days or for a number of weeks depending on its availability**



MAIN STORYBOARDS


- Depending on space available, exhibition can consist of 1, 2 or 4 boards
- Each double-sided board measures: 2235mm(h) x 1253mm(w) x 324mm(d)
- The exhibition requires a space in which it can be free-standing. It cannot be placed against a wall
- Each board is lightweight and easy to erect or move


