



Making T100 2021 a Covid-safe festival

Pre-booking for events is essential. Upon booking everyone must confirm they agree to our Covid-19 walk guidelines.

Ticket limit all events are restricted and the number of tickets for each event is in line with the government guidelines at the time, as booking online is required this can be amended as necessary.

Separate booking for walks and activities at times walks and/or activities are separated to ensure there is more opportunity to access them without exceeding the maximum number of participants.

Event space: All outdoor areas have been measured to determine the number of people that can be in each area whilst maintaining social distancing.

Event systems: For events in smaller outdoor spaces, walkers will be split into appropriately sized bubbles to ensure social distancing can be maintained. One way or rotation systems will be in place for when it is not possible for all groups to take part at one time.

Indoors optional: All indoor activities have been kept to a minimum but for those events that include them, participants can opt out if they prefer to remain outside. Indoor capacity has been determined by venue managers, based on their own Covid-19 guidelines.

Public toilets: To facilitate hand washing in between walks and making activities, all events have access to public toilets.

Hand sanitiser: This will be available for use at all events and before/after any making activities.

Sanitised kit: All walk kit, such as flag poles, will be cleaned before and after use.

PPE: Participants are instructed to bring masks for all festival activities at the point of booking and are reminded of the need to wear them when entering in door spaces as appropriate. Gloves will be provided as necessary for festival activities. If first aid is required to be administered during an event, first aiders will wear PPE as necessary.

Activity materials: to reduce possible cross contamination, items to be used for making activities will be sanitised before and after use and be divided up by the event staff for the participants. Participants will be instructed to sanitise in between use of different materials.

Food & drink: To reduce the need to enter shops on route, everyone is encouraged to bring their own and a picnic time has been scheduled for most activities. Everyone is also reminded to bring a face covering should the need arise to enter a shop. Some walks include refreshments or the option to buy refreshments, these will be served directly by the provider and consumed at the participants own risk.
